WHEN SHE WAS YOUNGER HER AND HER BEST FRIENDS WOULD TAKE ADVENTUROUS ROAD TRIPS TO CONCERTS ALL OVER.

KIKI MET HER BELOVED HUSBAND ROBERT WAYNE COX IN THE EARLY 80S AND THEY WERE MARRIED ON FEBRUARY 14, 1994. KIKI JOINED HER BELOVED HUSBAND, PARENTS, AND GRANDPARENTS WHO HAD PROCEEDED HER IN DEATH.
