



Guy Albert Sherburne, known to friends as the “Sheriff,” passed away on May 30, 2018, at the age of 66.

A native of Newport Oregon, Guy joined the Air Force on October 27, 1972 and served his country honorably as a Security Force Member for 26 years. He retired at the rank of Senior Master Sergeant on October 31, 1998. He traveled the world, serving his country. His first duty station was at McChord AFB, where he honed his skills as a Defender. He then traveled to Hickam AFB, Hawaii; Misawa AB, Japan; Osan AB, Republic of Korea; and finally, Security Hill, San Antonio, Texas where he eventually retired from the Air Force. He graduated from Park University with a degree in Management, Computer Information Systems.

In 1998, he was hired by PEC Solutions, Inc. as Senior Computer Security Specialist and Security Consultant and later promoted to Senior Systems Architect for Security. In 2000, he transferred to Evolvent, a wonderful small company that he loved; especially the people. He served as the Senior Vice President of Security Programs. He was a great contributor to the company and their success as it grew and was purchased by Man Tech in 2011. He contributed to the CyberSecurity community through numerous publications and presentations. Guy collaborated with Dennis Buxton as major contributors to the book, *Securing Business Intelligence: Knowledge and CyberSecurity in the Post-9/11 World*. Guy finally decided to retire in 2012, dedicating his time to family, gardening, and golf.

Guy will be lovingly remembered by his wife of 42 years, Janet Sanae Watanabe Sherburne and his children, Dave, Michael, Bernadette and Antoinette.
