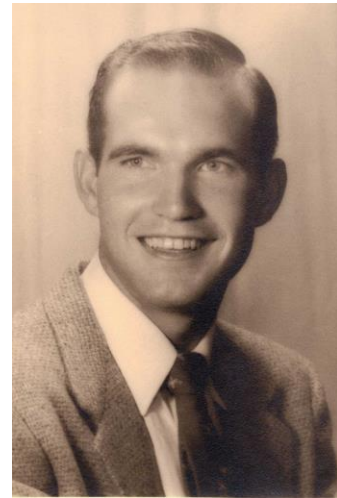


TRACY FRITZ SMITH

1934-2016

Tracy Fritz Smith, age 82, passed away at home on Sunday, October 30, 2016 after battling leukemia. He was born in Big Spring, Texas on July 17, 1934 to Tracy Thurman Smith and Helen Reagan Smith. Tracy was raised in Big Spring and earned a BBA in Accounting from Southern Methodist University in 1956. He served in the United States Army as an accounting clerk in the 7794 Saumur Signal Depot unit in France from 1957 to 1959.



Tracy married Flora Louise Onorati in 1959 in Big Spring and the couple made their home for three years in Brownsville, then in San Antonio. Tracy had a successful career as a CPA, retiring from Vaughan & Sons, Inc. as Vice President of Finance in 1990. He continued to prepare tax returns for family and friends until 2015. After retirement, Tracy and Flo had many adventures traveling all over the world. They also enjoyed watching wildlife and living quietly on their land in the San Antonio hill country. Tracy loved spending time with and helping his family, telling jokes, and laughing.

Tracy is survived by his loving wife of 57 years, Flo, son Marshall (Angie) Smith of San Antonio, daughter Roxane (Glen) Blanchard of Prosper, Texas, grandchildren Rebecca Smith (Ben) Hackett, Kristen Blanchard (Jason) Cox, Aaron Smith, and Robyn Blanchard, great-grandson Joshua Cox, sisters-in-law, nieces and nephews.

Tracy was preceded in death by his parents, Tracy T. and Helen Smith, brother Robert Smith, and sister Caroline Smith Ragsdale.

A rosary will be recited at 10:30 am, followed by a funeral mass at 11:00 am on Monday, November 21 at St. Pius X Catholic Church located at 3907 Harry Wurzbach in San Antonio. There will be a reception at the church after the mass and interment will take place at Ft. Sam Houston National Cemetery at 1:15 pm.
